As a Learning Engineer at the Faculty of Arts at the University of Lausanne (Switzerland), Nadia Spang Bovey is in charge of identifying pedagogical challenges, faced by both teachers and students, to be addressed with relevant technologies and non-traditional teaching and learning practices.
