Rob was the joint director of the HESP Project. The Director of the Centre for Recording Achievement (CRA) in the UK, for 25 years he has been at the leading edge of supporting the development of Personal Development Planning and the recording of achievement. He helped shape the initial policy for PDP in 1999-2000 and took a leading role in the revision of the sectoral Guidelines for Personal Development Planning (2009) and in the development of the QA toolkit in respect of extra-curricular awards (2013). He has also taken a leading role in the e-portfolio movement.

Rob was a member of the National Co-ordination Team for Student Employability in the UK and currently leads the UK contribution to the Europortfolio Project (the European Network of Eportfolio Experts and Practitioners). He is a Visiting Professor at the University of Bolton and holds an Honorary Doctorate from the University of Leicester.
