Since October 2008, as head of the Executive unit of AEQES, Caty DUYKAERTS has been responsible for implementing external evaluation procedures in the Belgian French-speaking higher education sector (universities, university colleges, art schools & conservatoires and adult education centres). She is much involved in designing and developing EQA procedures in a permanent dialogue with the stakeholders as well as in developing the IQA system of the agency. AEQES was first reviewed in 2011 and is now preparing its second review for 2016 against the new ESG. Since October 2012, she is an ENQA Board member and as such, she contributes to all the missions and tasks of the Board (see <http://www.enqa.eu/index.php/about-enqa/enqa-organisation/board/>).
